

This statement outlines the current position of Sabeti Wain Aerospace Ltd. (SWA) on the prevention of counterfeit parts in our supply base and subsequent assembly processes in response to regulatory directives. SWA understands the impact of these directives and is taking action to implement stringent anti- counterfeit procurement measures.

SWA is committed to refining and improving our existing Business Management System and procurement processes to effectively address the problem of counterfeit parts in the supply chain. Our internal aerospace procedures are aligned with the requirements of SAE AS5553 – Counterfeit Electronic Parts; Avoidance, Detection, Mitigation, and Disposition. SWA have modified our processes to meet relevant regulatory requirements as they are issued and made effective.

To mitigate the increasingly sophisticated counterfeiting activity in the supply of parts, SWA policies, procedures, and processes are aligned with industry standards. Decisions on materials and processes are made based upon data from industry studies and internal & external testing. Risks to programs and products are minimised through the implementation and adherence to a single company BMS based upon the aforementioned standards.
